____ (1). The Johnson Arts Center staff will decide on the next artist to exhibit one (1) month before exhibition opening to guarantee sufficient time for art to be dropped off and installed.

____ (2). The Johnson Arts Center does not provide insurance for artwork and cannot be held liable for any damage to objects on display.

____ (3). The Johnson Arts Center may accept or refuse individual objects submitted for consideration and does not need to exhibit all artwork submitted for consideration.

____ (4). The Artist affirms that they created the artwork in its entirety, unless additional artists are listed by name, and did not receive un-acknowledged help or utilized the help of artificial intelligence (AI).

____ (5). Each exhibition can be on display for a minimum of one (1) week, up to a maximum of two (2) months.

____ (6). Artwork must be framed and/or have sufficient hardware to be hung on the Gallery Wall. Three-dimensional artwork is not eligible for exhibition.

____ (7). There is no minimum or maximum number of objects that can be submitted for consideration, though objects chosen and displayed on the Gallery Wall must have sufficient space between each other. The Gallery Wall is roughly 15 feet of usable space.

____ (8). The Johnson Arts Center will provide tombstones containing each object's information to appear under artwork on the Gallery Wall.

____ (9). Exhibitions will be added to the Johnson Arts Center website with The Artist's permission.

____ (10). Any and all sales of artwork must be done between The Artist and potential buyers. The Johnson Arts Center will not facilitate any purchases.

____ (11). The Artist will not receive any monetary compensation for exhibition at the Johnson Arts Center.

____ (12). All artwork must be transported by The Artist or a separate responsible party.

____ (13). Artwork containing obscene materials as defined by the Utah State Code will not be eligible for consideration.

____ (14). The Artist can apply for consideration after previously being exhibited on the Gallery Wall, provided that The Artist is applying with artwork that was not previously exhibited on the Gallery Wall.

____ (15). Exhibition may be terminated at any time by The Artist or the Johnson Arts Center.

____ (16). The Artist may provide a preferred order or layout of artwork, though the Johnson Arts Center will have final approval of exhibition layout.

____ (17). Artwork will be installed by a member of the Johnson Arts Center staff, but The Artist may request to assist with or be present for installation.

By signing this application, The Artist acknowledges and agrees to the previous terms mentioned and are entering their artwork to be in consideration for exhibition on the Johnson Arts Center Gallery Wall.
